







Tatsuya:
















I am a scout for an entertainment agency. I am looking for potential idol candidates.

He lied about being an entertainment agency scout and pretends to be a nice guy to lure girls. He's a bad guy.









Summary

Episode 1: Protect yourself from online attacks!

Offers claiming free antivirus software to protect you from viruses are scams. Be careful not to fall for this trick. Always use legitimate antivirus software and keep it up to date.

Episode 2: Avoid becoming addicted to the internet!

Be careful not to fall into internet addiction, such as feeling anxious if you don't exchange dozens of emails with a friend in a day, getting absorbed in online games, or losing focus on your studies because you're caught up in file-sharing software.

Episode 3: Don't give in to cyberbullying!

If you are bullied or insulted online, don't struggle alone. Talk to a teacher or family member for support. Severe bullying is a crime, so you should go to the police. They can trace the person who wrote it quickly.

Episode 4: Be cautious about meeting people you've met online.

Be cautious, as some people you meet through profiles or social media may have malicious intentions. Instead of meeting them on your own, talk to a teacher or a friend for advice.
